Our Intent for Assessment & Reporting Pupil Achievement

Examination Homework:

In preparation for calendared assessments, all pupils will receive examination homework which is **compulsory**. Pupils will receive teacher developed resources in a booklet for revision, 6 weeks prior to their assessment week. Tasks are designed to develop revision skills, retrieve prior knowledge and develop the skills and habits for successful achievement in examinations. The examination booklet should be completed at home and teachers will monitor these during lessons. Classcharts rewards will be used to acknowledge completion.

Assessment Weeks

At Saint John Wall Catholic School, pupils are provided with lots of practice to build knowledge and skills fluently across the curriculum:

- Year 7x2 – Baseline assessments. Pupils gain sufficient time to develop curriculum knowledge and skills until the final assessment in Year 8.
- Year 8x1 – To support pupils and teachers with option preferences in the Pathways process.
- Year 9x2 - Provides evidence for setting and suitability of courses selected for pathways. Pupils begin to build their knowledge and skills at GCSE level.
- Year 10x3 – Pupils build knowledge and skills fluency. Pupils are provided with the opportunity for spaced/ interleaved retrieval practice.
- Year 11x2 – Provides opportunities for pupils to close the gaps in their learning and make marginal gains. Pupils are prepared 'for the next stage of education, employment or training.'

Parents Afternoons/Evenings & Reports

Following an Assessment Week, parents/ carers will receive a school report on their child's progress. You will have the opportunity to discuss achievement and any further support your child may need to succeed with teachers.
